

How to Tell Your Doctor's Office About RGA of Idaho

Many people think that Regence Group Administrators of Idaho (RGA of Idaho) is actually Regence BlueShield. This is an honest mistake. We both manage health benefits. And our names and our logos are almost the same. RGA of Idaho is a separate company with our own health plans, and different addresses and phone numbers.

Why does this matter to me?

Your doctor's office might contact Regence BlueShield by mistake and be told that you are not showing up as a member. That is because your doctor's office called the wrong health plan. The payment of claims may be delayed, or even denied, if your claim is sent to Regence BlueShield instead of RGA of Idaho.

Make sure they contact **RGA of Idaho**.

How can I help clear the confusion?

1.

When showing your RGA of Idaho member ID card to your doctor's office, make sure to tell them that you are with RGA of Idaho and not Regence BlueShield.



Point out the different phone numbers, mailing address, and claims payer ID on the back of your member ID card.
